

PERO

<u>Purpose</u>

To provide in-depth analysis of the provincial economy that could be used as the basis for policy decisions as well information for other stakeholders and the public at large.

Scope

The publication is produced annually and provides analysis of the provincial economy in terms of production, sectoral activity, the labour market and the municipal economy.

- Municipal Economic Performance



SERO

Purpose

Provides a detailed analysis of the socio-economic indicators essential for developing and implementing policy and helps track development goals.

Scope

Published annually and analyses socio-economic indicators at both the provincial and municipal level.

Publication Contents for 2010

- •Gauteng Socio-economic Review
- •Municipal Level Analysis to include: Demographic profile, economic review, employment, access to services, development and municipal sustainability



Challenges- PERO & SER

- Data challenges discrepancies between sources and unavailability of some data, especially at municipal level.
- SER Publication did not include the outlook section due to non-delivery by Service Provider.











Quarterly Bulletins & Economic Newsletters

Quarterly Bulletins

Research on a particular topic of interest in the province.

Weekly Economic Newsletters

Topics cover current economic events and provide a snapshot of the global, national & provincial economy.

Challenges

Lack of awareness about publications and difficulties in distributing publications.

Impact Studies

<u>Purpose</u>
